I know you know that. It's the front gate. I really need to talk to you guys. Scott. Are you OK? Yeah. Have either of you guys ever studied quantum physics? Only to make conversation. All right, so, five years ago, right before Thanos, I was in a place called the Quantum Realm. The Quantum Realm is like its own microscopic universe. Yeah. What the? Something died in here. Hello? Thor? You hear about the cable? The Cinemax went out two weeks ago. The sports are all kind of fuzzy. Thor? Oh my God. That time stone guy. Yeah, Doctor Strange. Yeah, what kind of doctor was he? Ear nose throat meets rabbit from Hab. Nice place in the village, though. He on Sullivan Street? Mmm, Bleeker. Shut the front door. All right, we have a plan. Six stones. Three teams, one shot. Five years ago we lost. All of us. We lost friends. We lost family. We lost a part of ourselves. Today we have a chance to take it all back. You know your teams, you know your missions. Get the stones, get them back. One round trip each. No mistakes. No do-overs. Most of us are going somewhere we know. That doesn't mean you should know what to expect. Be careful. Look out for each other. This is the fight of our lives. And we're gonna win. Whatever it takes. Good luck. He's pretty good at that. All right, you heard the man. Stroke those keys, Jolly Green. Tractor's engaged. You promised to bring that back in one piece, right? Yeah, yeah, yeah, yeah. Okay, I'll do my best. Just promises, girl. That was pretty lame. See you in a minute. All right, we all have our assignments. Two stones uptown, one stone down. Stay low. Keep an eye on the clock. Maybe smash a few things along the way. I think it's gratuitous, but whatever. I'd be careful going that way. We just had the floors waxed. I'm looking for Doctor Strange. You're about. Five years too early. Stephen Strange is currently performing surgery about 20 blocks that way. What do you want from him? That, actually. I'm afraid not. Sorry, but I wasn't asking. You don't want to do this. You're right, I don't, but I need that stone that I don't have time to bait. Let's start over, shall we? Do you have anything? Pants. Pants. Never mind. These will be fine. Thank you. Oh, that's Jane. All right. Here's the deal, tubby. You're gonna charm her, and I'm gonna poke her with this thing and extract a reality stone and get gone lickety-split. I'll be right back, okay? This, uh, the wine cellar is just down here. My father used to have this huge barrel of eco and eat ale. I'll see if the celery has a couple of little cups. Hey, hey! Aren't you drunk enough already? Yes, ma'am, can you ask our librarian Who's the fancy broad? It's my mother. She dies today. That's today? I can't do this. I can't do this. I shouldn't be here. I shouldn't have come. Come here. No, I think I'm heavy. I'm heavy. I'm heavy. Come here. Right here. You think you're the only one who lost people? What do you think we're doing here? I lost the only family I ever had. Quill, Groot, Drax, the chick with the antenna, all gone. I get you miss your mom, but she's gone. Really gone. And there are plenty of people who are only kinda gone, and you can help them. So is it too much to ask that you brush the crumbs out of your beard, make Schmoopy talk to Pretty Pants, and when she's not looking, Suck out the Infinity Stone and help me get my family back. Okay. Are you crying? No. Yes. I feel like I'm losing it. Get it together. You can do this. You can do this. All right? Yes, I can. Good. I can do this. I can do this. All right, heartbreaker, she's alone. This is our shot. Thor? Thor! All right, bring it down, Blue. Right on that line. That's it. Down, down. Hey, can we hurry it up? Guys, chop,

chop. Come on, we're on the clock. All that, it's really helpful. Okay. Get that stone and come back. No messing around. Okay. We got this. Let's get it done. Yes, sir. See you back. You guys watch each other's six. Yeah. Coordinates before me are laid in. All they have to do is not fall out. It's a long way from Budapest. Okay, so we just wait around for this quill guy to show up, and then he leads us to the Power Stone. Is that it? Let's take cover. We're not the only ones in 2014 looking for the stones. Wait a minute. What are you talking about right now? Who else is looking for these stones? My father, my sister, and me. And you? Where are you right now? You're welcome. I didn't ask for your help. And yet you always need it. Get up. Father wants us back on the ship. Why? He's found an Infinity Stone. Where? On a planet called Morag. Father's plan is finally in motion. One stone is in six, Nebula. It's a start if he gets all of them. Ronan's located the Power Stone. I'm dispatching you to his ship. He won't like that. His alternative is death. Ronan's obsession clowns his judgment. We will not fail you, Father. No, you won't. I swear. I will make you proud. We just wait around for this quill guy to show up and then he leads us to the Power Stone. Is that it? Let's take cover. We're not the only ones in 2014 looking for the stones. Who was that? I don't know. My head is splitting. I don't know. Her synaptic drive was probably damaged in battle. Shh. Bring her to my ship. Better hostile cap. Things look like they're just about wrapped up here. Got it. I'm approaching the elevator now. If it's all the same to you. I'll have that drink now. All right, get him on his feet. And I'll stand around posing up a storm later. By the way, feel free to clean up. Mr. Rogers, I almost forgot that that suit did nothing for your ***. No one asked you to look, Tony. That's ridiculous. I think you look great, Cap. As far as I'm concerned, that's America's ***. Who gets the magic wand? Strike team's coming to secure. We can take that off your hands. By all means. Careful with that thing. You guys want your mind erased, another fun away. We promise to be careful. Who are these guys? They are Shield. Well, actually Hydra, but we didn't know that yet. Seriously? You didn't? I mean, they look like bad guys. You're small, but you're talking loud. On my way down to coordinate search and rescue. On my way down to coordinate search and rescue. I mean, honestly, how do you keep your food... Shut up. All right, you're up, little buddy. There's a power stone. All right. Flick me. Whoa! Hey, buddy! What do you think? Maximum occupancy has been reached. Take the steps. Yes. Stop, stop. Take the stairs. Take the stairs. All right, Cap, I got our scepter in the elevator just passing the 80th floor. On it. Head to the lobby. All right, I'll see you there. Evidence secure. We're en route to Doctor List. No? hitches at all, Mr. Secretary. Captain? I thought you were coordinating search and rescue. Change of plans. Hey, Cap. Rumlow? I just got a call from the secretary. I'm gonna be running point on the scepter. Sir, I don't understand. We got word there may be an attempt to steal it. Sorry, Cap. They can't give you the scepter. I'm gonna have to call the director. That's okay. Trust me. Hey, Elijah. So many stairs! Thumbelina, do you copy? I've got eyes on the prize. It is go time. Bombs away. Is that Axe body spray? Yeah, I had a can to the desk for emergencies, Raxe. Can we focus, please? I'm going inside. Now. May I ask you where you're going? The lunch and

then Asgard. I'm sorry, you are? Alexander Pierce. He's the man above the folks behind Nick Fury. My friends call me Mr. Secretary. I'm going to have to ask you to turn that prisoner over to me. Loki will be answering to Odin himself. No, he's going to answer to us. Odin can have what's left. And I'm going to need that case. That's been SHIELD property for over 70 years. All right, move it, Stuart. Little things are getting dicey out here. Let's go. I'm gonna argue who's got the higher authority here, right? You promise me you won't die? You're only getting me a mild cardiac dysrhythmia. That doesn't sound mild. I need the case. I know you got a lot of pull. I'm just saying... Okay, then give me the case. Well, just... Get your hands off me. The window's closing. Pull my pin. Hey, here it goes. He's convulsing. Good mayor. Medic. Medic! You got some help? Speeching. Doc, do you know chest machines? Good job. Meet me in the alley. I'm gonna grab a quick slice. No stairs! Come on, start. Stay with us. Let me try something, okay? I have no idea if it's gonna work. Yes! That worked a treat. You thought it was so crazy. I had no idea if that was gonna work. The case. The case. Where's the case? Where's Loki? Loki! That wasn't supposed to happen, was it? Oh, we blew it. Loki! Tony, what's going on? Tell me you found that cube. you can't be ***** me. I have eyes on Loki, 14th floor. I'm not Loki. And I don't want to hurt you. I can do this all day. Yeah, I know. Where did you get this? Bucky is alive! Get out! That is America's ***. Please, please-- I'm sorry, I can't help you, Bruce. If I give up the time stone to help your reality, I'm dooming my own. With all due respect, I'm not sure the science really supports that. The Infinity Stones create what you experience as the flow of time. Remove one of the stones and that flow splits. Now this may benefit your reality, but my new one, not so much. In this new branch reality, without our chief weapon against the forces of darkness, our world would be overrun. Millions will suffer. So tell me, Doctor, can your science prevent all that? No. We can erase it, because once we're done with the stones, we can return each one to its own timeline at the moment it was taken. So, chronologically, in that reality, it never left. Yes, but you're leaving out the most important part. In order to return the stones, you have to survive. We will. I will. I promise. I can't risk this reality on a promise. It's the duty of the Sorcerer Supreme to protect the Time Stone. But why the hell did Strange give it away? What did he say? Strange, he gave it away. He gave it to Thanos. Willingly? Yes. Why? I have no idea. Maybe he made a mistake. Or I did. Strange is meant to be the best of us. So he must have done it for a reason. I fear you might be right. Thank you. I'm counting on you, Bruce. We all are. Run diagnostics. Show me your memory file. Sire, the file appears entangled. It was a memory, but not hers. There's another consciousness sharing her network. Another nebula. Impossible. This duplicate carries a time stamp from 9 years in the future. Where is this other nebula? In our solar system, on Morag. Can you access her? Yes, the two are linked. Search the duplicate's memories for Infinity Stones. And these stones died in a lot of different places throughout history. Art history, so not a lot of convenience. Spots to just drop in. Yeah, but if you have to pick our targets, click. Freeze image. Terran. Avengers. Unruly wretches. What's that reflection? Amplify this

moment. I don't understand. Two nebulas. No. The same nebula. From 2 different times. Set course for Morak and scan the duplicate's memories. I want to see everything. Ladies, I'll see you after. What are you doing? Oh, God. You're better off leaving the sneaking to your brother. I was thinking of just going for a walk. What are you wearing? I always wear this. It's one of my favourites. What's wrong with your eye? Oh, my, that's, you remember the Battle of Harroquin when I got hit in the face with the broadsword? You're not the Thor I know at all, are you? Yes, I am. The future hasn't been kind to you, has it? I didn't say I was from the future. I was raised by a witch's boy. I see with more than eyes your mother. Totally from the future. I really didn't talk to you. We can talk. His head was over there. His body over there. What was the point? I was too late. I was just standing there. An idiot with an axe. No, you're no idiot. You're here, aren't you? Seeking counsel from the wisest person in Asgot. Yeah, yes. An idiot now. A failure? Absolutely. He's a little bit harsh. Do you know what that makes you? Just like everyone else. I'm not supposed to be like everyone else, am I? Everyone fails at who they're supposed to be Thor. The measure of a person, of a hero, is how well they succeed at being who they are. Really mystery, Mum. I get it! Get that rabbit! Mum, I have to tell you something. No, son, you don't. You're here to repair your future, not mine. This is about your future. Hi. You must be Mom. I got the thing. Come on, we gotta move. I wish we had more time. No, this was a gift. Now you go and be the man you're meant to be. I love you, Mom. I love you. Then eat a salad. Come on, we gotta go. Three, two-- No, wait! What am I looking at? Oh, sometimes it takes a second. I'm still worthy. Oh, boy. Goodbye, mama. No matter with your head, baby, find it Come on and find it, hell With it, baby, 'cause you're fine and you're mine And you look so divine Come and get your love Come and get your love All your hell So he's an idiot. Yeah. What's that? The tool of a thief. Whoa, whoa, whoa, whoa, whoa. This is the part where, you know, spikes come out with skeletons on the end of them and everything. What are you talking about? When you break into a place called the Temple of the Power Stone, there's gonna be a bunch of booby traps. Okay. All right. Go ahead. I wasn't always like this. Me either. But we work with what we got, right? Sync up. Three, two, one. Where are the stones? Gone reduced to atoms. You used them two days ago. I used the stones to destroy the stones. It nearly killed me. But the work is done. It always will be. I am Inevitable. What did you do to them? Nothing. Yet. They're not trying to stop something I'm going to do in our time. They're trying to undo something I've already done in theirs. The stones. I found them all. I won. Tip the cosmic scales to balance. This is your future. It's my destiny. My father has many things. A liar is not one of them. Thank you, daughter. Perhaps I treated you too harshly. And that is destiny fulfilled. Sire. Your daughter. No. He's a traitor. That's not me. That's not. I could never. I would never betray you. Never. I know. And you'll have the chance to prove it. No. He knows. Martin. Martin, come in. Rana. Come in, we have a problem. Come in, we have a... Vanoss knows. Vanoss. Cap. Sorry, buddy, we got a problem. Yeah, we do. what are we going to do now? You know what? Give me a break, Steve. I just got hit in the head with the Hulk.

You said that we had one shot. Yes, this was our shot. We shot it. It's shot. Six stones or nothing. Six stones or nothing. You're repeating yourself. You know that? You're repeating yourself. You're repeating yourself. You're repeating yourself. You know, no. If you never wanted a time heist, you weren't on board with the time heist, you ruined the time heist. Is that what I did? Yeah. Are there any other options with the Tesseract? No, there's no other options. There's no do-overs. We're not going anywhere else. We have one particle left each. That's it. All right? We use that. Bye, bye. You're not going home. Yeah, well, if we don't try, then no one else is going home either. We got it. There's another way to retake the Tesseract and acquire new particles. We'll stroll down memory lane. Military installation, Garden Stand. When were they both there? They were there at a time of, I have a vaguely exact idea. How vague. What are you talking about? What are we, where are we going? I know for a fact they were there. Who's they? What are we doing? Guys, what's the, what is it? Looks like we're improvising. Great. What are we improvising? Scott, get this back to the compound. Shoot up. What's in New Jersey? Zero 4, 0 4, 0 7, 0 7. Excuse me. Are you sure? Cap, Captain, Steve. Sorry, America, Rogers. Look, if you do this and it doesn't work, you're not coming back. It's actually the pep talk, Pishant. You trust me? Me too. You're calm. Here we go. Hey, man! Make love not worse! Clearly, you weren't actually born. The idea of me was. Right. Well, imagine your SHIELD running a quasi-fascistic intelligence organization. Where do you hide it? In plain sight. Good luck on your mission, Captain. Good luck on your project, Doctor. You new here? Not exactly. Got you. Back in the game. Are you in there? Are you? Hey, the door's this way, pal. Oh, yeah. I'm looking for Dr. Zola. Have you seen him? Yeah, Dr. Zola. No, I haven't seen a soul. Pardon me. Do I know you? No, sir. I'm a visitor from MIT. Oh, MIT. Got a name? Howard. Well, that'll be easy to remember. Howard Potts. Well, I'm Howard Stark. Hi. Shake that. Don't pull it. Yeah. You look a little green around the gills there, Potts. I'm fine. Just long hours. You want to get some air? Hello, Potts. Yeah. That'll be swell. That way. OK. Need your briefcase. You're not one of those beatniks, are you, Potts? Hello? Doctor Pym? That would be the number that you called, yes? This is Captain Stevens from shipping. We have a package for you. Bring it up. Well, if that's the thing, sir, we can't. I'm confused. I thought that was your job. Well, it's just, sir, the box is glowing, and to be honest, some of our mail guys aren't feeling that great. They didn't open it, did they? Yeah, they did. You better get down here. Excuse me, out of the way. Flowers and sauerkraut. You got a big date tonight? My wife's expecting, and too much time in the office. Congratulations. Thanks. Hold this, will you? Yeah, sure. How far along is she? I don't know. She's at the point where she can't stand the sound of my chewing. I guess I'll be eating dinner in the pantry again. I have a little girl. A girl would be nice. Less of a chance she'd turn out exactly like me. What would be so awful about that? Let's just say that the greater good has rarely outweighed my own self-interest. You've never seen these two men before? No, I've got an eye for this. The two of them look fishy. Can you describe them? Well, one of them had a hippie beard. Hippie, like Bee Gees or Mungo Jerry? Definitely Mungo

Jerry. Yeah, this is Chesler. I need every available MP to sub-level 6. We have a potential breach. And so, where are you at with names? Well, if it's a boy, my wife likes Almonzo. Huh. Might want to let that stew a while. You got time. Let me ask you a question. When a kid was born, were you nervous? Wildly. Oh. Yeah. Did you feel qualified? Like, you had any idea how to successfully operate that thing? I literally pieced it together as I went along. I thought about what my dad did and... My old man, he never met a problem he couldn't solve with a belt. I thought my dad was tough on me, and now, looking back on it, I just remember the good stuff. You know, he did drop the odd pearl. Yeah? Like what? No amount of money he ever bought a second of time. Smart guy. He did his best. I tell you, that kid's not even here yet, and there's nothing I wouldn't do for him. Good to meet you, Potts. Yeah. Howard, everything's gonna be all right. Thank you for everything. You down for this country. Jarvis. Have we ever met that guy? You meet a lot of people, son. Seems very familiar. Weird beard. You're weak. I'm you. You could stop this. You know you want to. Did you see what happens in the future? Thanos finds the Soul Stone. You want to know how he does that? You want to know what he does to you? That's enough. You disgust me. But that doesn't mean you're useless. How do I look? Wow. There are different circumstances. This would be totally awesome. I bet the raccoon didn't have to climb a mountain. Technically, he's not a raccoon, you know. Oh, whatever. He eats garbage. Welcome. Natasha, daughter of Ivan. Clint, son of Edith. Who are you? Consider me a guide to you and to all who see the Soul Stone. Oh, good. You tell us where it is, then we'll be on our way. Oh, Liebsch. If only it were that easy. What you seek lies in front of you, as does what you fear. The stone's on there. For one of you. For the other. In order to take the stone, you must lose that which you love. An everlasting exchange. A soul for a soul. How's it going? Jesus. Maybe he's making this **** up. No. I don't think so. Not because he knows your daddy's name? I didn't. Thanos left here with the stone. Without his daughter, it's not a coincidence. Yeah. Whatever it takes. Whatever it takes. If we don't get that stone, billions of people stay dead. And I guess we both know who it's got to be. I guess we do. You're starting to think we mean different people here, Natasha. The last five years, I've been trying to do one thing, get to right here. That's all it's been about, bringing everybody back. Now don't you get all decent on me now. What, you think I want to do it? I'm trying to save your life, you idiot. Yeah, well, I don't want you to. How's that? Natasha, you know what I've done. You know what I've become. I don't judge people on their worst mistake. Maybe you should. You didn't. You're a pain in my *** you know that. Okay. You win. I tell my family I love them. You tell them yourself. Damn you. Let me go. No. Please, no. It's okay. Please. Did we get them all? Are you telling me this actually worked? Clint, where's Nat? Do we know if she had family? No. Us. What? What are you doing? What are you doing? She asked me a question. Yeah, no, you're acting like she's dead. Why are we acting like she's dead? We have the stones, right? As long as we have the stones, Cap, we can bring her back. Isn't that right to stop this **** with the Avengers going together? I can't get her back. It can't be undone. It can't. Look, I'm sorry, no offense, but you're a

very earthly being, okay? We're talking about space magic. And Kant seems very definitive, don't you think? Yeah, look, I know that I'm way outside my peg right here, but she's still in here, is she? No, that's my point. It can't be undone. Or that's at least what the red floating guy had to say. Maybe you want to go talk to him, okay? Go grab your hammer and you go fly and you talk to him. It's supposed to be me. Sacrifice her life for that ***** stone. She'd better live on it. She's not coming back. We have to make it worth it. We have to. We will. All right, the glove's ready. Question is, who's gonna snap their frickin' fingers? I'll do it. Excuse me? It's okay. No, wait, wait, wait. Just wait. We haven't decided who's gonna put that on you. I'm sorry, we're all just sitting around waiting for the right opportunity. We should at least discuss it. No, sitting here staring at the thing is not going to bring everybody back. I'm the strongest avenger, okay? So this responsibility falls upon me. It's my duty. No, it's not that. Shh, stop it. Just let me. Just let me do it. Just let me do something good. Something right. Look, it's not just the fact that glove is channeling enough energy to light up a continent. I'm telling you, you're in no condition. What do you think is coursing through my veins right now? Cheese Whiz? Lightning. Yeah. Lightning. Lightning won't help you, pal. It's gotta be me. You saw those stones to the Thanos. They almost killed them. None of you could survive. How do we know you will? We don't. But the radiation's mostly gamma. It's like, uh... I was made for this. Good to go? Yeah? Let's do it. Okay, remember, everyone Thanos snapped away five years ago, we're just bringing them back to now, today. Don't change anything from the last five years. Got it. Friday, do me a favor and activate barn door protocol, will you? Yes, boss. Everybody comes home. Take it off! Take it off! No, wait, Bruce, are you okay? Talk to me, Banner. I'm okay. I'm okay. Bruce! Don't move it. Did it work? No, it's okay. Hi. Guys. I think it worked. I can't breathe, I can't breathe, I can't breathe! Canopy, canopy, canopy! Brody Rocket, get out of here! Let me up! Let me up! Come on! Hey Brody! Huh? Mayday, Mayday, does anybody copy? We're on the lower level of spawning. What? What? We're drowning. Does anybody copy Mayday? Wait. I'm here. I'm here. Can you hear me? Ah. Jeff? Daughter. Yes, Father. So this is the future. Well done. Thank you, Father. I suspected nothing. Yeah, I could never do. Go. Find the stones. Bring them to me. What will you do? Wait. Tell me something. In the future, what happens to you and me? I try to kill you. Several times. But eventually, we become friends. We become sisters. Come on. We can stop him. Come on, buddy, wake up. That's my man. Lose this again? I'm keeping it. What happened? If you mess with time, it tends to mess back. You'll see. What's he been doing? Absolutely nothing. Where are the stones? Somewhere under all this. All I know is he doesn't have them. So we keep it that way. You know it's a trap, right? Yeah, I don't much care. Good. Just as long as we're all in agreement. Let's kill him properly this time. You could not live with your own failure. Where did that bring you? Back to me. I thought by eliminating half of life, the other half will thrive. But you've shown me that's impossible. And as long as there are those that remember what was, there will always be those that are unable to accept what can be. They will resist. Yep, we're all kinds of stubborn. I'm thankful. Because

now, I know what I must do. I will shred this universe down to its last atom. And then, with the stones you've collected for me, create a new one, teeming with life that knows not what it has lost, but only what it has been given. A grateful universe. Born out of blood. They'll never know it. Because you won't be alive to tell them. See you on the other side. Hang on! I'm coming! Oh, hey. I know you. Father, I have the stones. What? Stop. You're betraying us. You don't have to do this. I am this. No, you're not. You've seen what we become. Nebula listened to her. You can change. He won't let me. No! Okay, Thor, hit me. Boss, wake up. I knew it. In all my years of conquest, violence, slaughter, it was never personal. But I'll tell you now, what I'm about to do to your stubborn, annoying little planet, I'm gonna enjoy it very, very much. Captain Reamy. Captain Sam, can you hear me? On your left. Is that everyone? But you wanted more? Avengers! Assemble. No, no, give me that. You have the little one. Hey! Holy cow, you will not believe what's been going on. Do you remember when we were in space? And I got all dusty? And I must have passed out because I woke up and you were gone. But Doctor Strange was there, right? And he was like, it's been five years, come on, they need us. And then he started doing the yellow sparkly thing that he does all the time. What are you doing? Oh, this is nice. Gamora? I thought I lost you. Touch me! You missed the first time. Then you got them both the second time. This is the one? Seriously? Your choices were him or a dream. What do you want me to do with this damn thing? Get those stones as far away as possible! No! We need to get them back where they came from. No way to get them back, Thanos destroyed the quantum tunnel. Hold on. That wasn't our only time machine. Anyone see an ugly brown van out there? Yes, you're not going to like where it's parked. Scott, how long you need to get that thing working? Maybe 10 minutes. Get it started. We'll get the stones to you. We're on it, Cap. Hey, you said one out of 14 million, we win, yeah? Tell me this is it. If I tell you what happens, it won't happen. You better be right. It's a mess back here. It's dead. What? It's dead. I have to hotwire it. Where's Nebula? She's not responding. Saya. great give it to me you took everything from me I don't even know who you are you will I got it! Activate instant kill! Rain fire! But sire, our troops just do it! Is anyone else seeing this? I got this. I got this. Okay, I don't got this. Help! Somebody help! Hey, queens, heads up. Hang on. I got you, kid. Hey, nice to meet you. Oh, my God! What the hell is this? Friday, what are they firing at? Something just entered the upper atmosphere. Oh, yeah! Dampers, we need an assist here. I am. Peter Parker. Hey, Peter Parker. You got something for me? I don't know how you're gonna get us through all of that. Don't worry. She's got health. Got you. inevitable. And I am Iron Man. Mrs. Stark. Hey. Mrs. Stark, can you hear me? It's Peter. Hey. We won. Mrs. Stark. You won, Mr. Stark. You won. You did it, sir. You did it. I'm sorry, Dodie. Friday. Look at me. We're gonna be okay. You can rest now. Everybody wants a happy ending, right? But it doesn't always roll that way. Maybe this time. I'm hoping if you play this back, it's in celebration. I hope families are reunited. I hope you get it back in something like a normal version of the planet that's been restored. If there ever was such a thing, capital world, universe now. If you told me

10 years ago that we weren't alone, let alone, you know, to this extent, I mean, I wouldn't have been surprised, but come on, who knew? The epic forces of darkness and light that have come into play.
