Speaker 9

See you inside.

Speaker 19

I'll see you inside my brother.

Speaker 9

This is president.

Speaker 16

Right on black power.

Speaker 21

The Black Student Union of Colorado College is honoured to bring the vanguard of revolutionaries fighting for the rights of black people all over the world. Let's go to the black love to the one and only the brother man with the plan who is sticking it to the man. Put your hands together. My people for all. Why be too red.

Thank you.

Speaker 17

Mr Patrice and the Black Student union.

Speaker 9

Thank you.

Speaker 17

I want to thank all of you. My beloved sisters and brothers, for coming out tonight. But I'm here tonight to tell you. That it is time. For you to stop running away from being black.

Right.

Speaker 24

It is time for you to stop running away from being black. You're college students, right? It's time for you to understand that you, as the growing intellectuals of this country that you must define beauty for black people. Now that's black power. Actually something.

Speaker 17

His beauty, defined as someone with a narrow nose.

Speaker 24

Thin lips. White skin? Hell no. Hell no.

Speaker 17

Because you ain't got none of. That.

Speaker 16

OK.

Speaker 24

Our lips are thick. Our nose is bored out. Hair is nappy, we are black and we are beautiful. You see, we want to be so much like the white people who oppress us in this country. And because they hate us, and because we are ashamed of our African heritage, we then hate ourselves.

Y'all don't hear me tonight. \*\*\*\* there. Tarzan, I'm gonna be honest. When I was a boy. I used to go. To the Saturday matinees and watch Tarzan. All the time.

Speaker 24

And white Tarzan used to beat up the black natives. And I would sit there yelling kill the beast. Kill the savages. Kill them. Kill them. Kill them, kill them. But what I was saying was kill me. It was as if a young Jewish boy saw Nazis taking Jews off the concentration camps and cheered them on. Today, I want those chiefs to beat the hell out of Tarzan and send his Lily white \*\*\* going back to the caves.

But it takes time. It takes time to become free of the lies and their shaming effects on the black mind. It takes time to reject the most important lie that black people. Do the same things. That white people do.

They live in captive communities and they must endure their oppression and their conditions because and only because they are black and powerless.

Now we are being shot down like dogs in the streets by white racist cops. Shut down in the streets by white racist cops. We can no longer endure this kind of oppression without retribution.

That's war in Vietnam.

Speaker 24

That. It is not only illegal, it is immoral. And you know what I tell them. Hell no, we won't go.

Speaker 4

We won't go help. We will go. We won't. We won't go. I'd rather see.

Speaker 24

A brother kill a white racist cop, then kill a Vietnamese. Because at least. If he kills a racist cop, he is doing it for a reason because they are shooting black people in the backs in these. Streets right here in this very country. They're killing us like dogs right here. Right here.

I. Want to leave? You in closing, because I know it's getting late and y'all gotta go party. I'm sorry study. I just want to leave you, sisters and brothers, with these last words. If I am not for myself. Who will be?

If I'm for myself alone, who am I? If not now, win, and if not you, who? Oh. We need an undying love for black people wherever we may be, all power to all the people, all power.

People. Pretty powerful stuff.

Incredible words, brother. Kwame, thank you so much.

Speaker 19

It sounds like they're watching us. I don't know. I don't know. We're supposed.

Speaker 17

Sleep.

Speaker

To do.

Speaker 19

Look at this \*\*\*\*\*.

Speaker 9

Where did you find these?

Speaker 19

Class it all over my windshield, but they're over the neighbourhood too. Is this real?

Speaker 9

Real as can be.

Speaker 19

Intimidation.

Speaker 9

Clearly this is about the black student. Union. And you, me, you've been outspoken about the incident with the police, but the quality was here or they're just trying to get to you intimidate. Like you said, fear tactics scare you.

Speaker 19

So next.

Speaker 9

They got nothing. Keep your eyes open. Be cool.

Speaker 31

OK, that's the damn problem. We always too.

Speaker 11

Cool way too cool.

Speaker 9

Then maybe we should call the.

Speaker 14

Police how we know this ain't some of the KKK's \*\*\*\*\* pig partners passing out this \*\*\*\*\*.

Speaker 9

Let me ask you, excuse us. Let me ask you.

Speaker 30

Something for what? I'm.

Speaker 28

Gonna be cool. I'd be cool.

Speaker 2

And also safeguards against the CSPD, which is nice.

Speaker 20

Yeah.

Speaker 2

Yeah, you're soaked. The wood and kerosene. Well, you're sitting on a pack of matches that kind of buys you some time to get the \*\*\*\*\* out before the cross catches fire. Oh yeah, it is. It's great. It's real bonfire. You can see it from miles away, you know. Good

visibility, as Walter would say. Freaks out the Jew media and it. Oh, keeps negative on the negative. Ohh yeah, damn no. The pigs are. Pigs are out tonight.

Speaker 23

Programme dares to love white people, white heritage, white freedom. This programme also dares to expose the Jewish supremacism, old media and the criminal banking establishment. These criminal bankers, the criminal fed, the establishment.

Speaker 2

Here come. Boys. They build the cavalry.

Speaker 16

This.

Speaker 23

They're ethnically cleansing our people. Not only in the United States. Not only the United States. The only the only. Thing that we hear today from politicians.

Speaker 27

Now.

Speaker 32

Cross burning is off. Too many cops got damn.

Speaker 23

I love the Jewish people and the Jewish people are always our friends, no matter what they do matter how much they destroy our country. It's just wonderful. You know, we just love the Jews. Speaker 9

Speaker 23

Yum Yum.

Speaker 9

May and butter biscuit play together every day. One day my father came home early from work. He told me I couldn't play with that little spook anymore because I was white and butter biscuit was a.

Speaker 23

It's so rich. Well, your father sounds like a terrific man.

Speaker 9

He was a true American, taught me what was right.

Speaker 23

This is why we need more people like you and me. In public office. Get this country back on track. Amen for America to achieve its. It's greatness again.

Speaker 9

Absolutely. Boy, I sure wish we had a chance to chat face to face.

Speaker 23

In due time, my friend, in due time I will be in Colorado Springs for your initiation.

Speaker 9

You're coming to Colorado Springs, Sir.

Speaker 23

You bet your Mayflower society. Yes, I am. You're darn Tooting.

Speaker 31

Speaker 6

Speaker 9

Well, I'm anxious to meet. You.

Speaker 23

Excited to meet you too, Ron.

Speaker 9

Aren't you ever concerned of some smart Alec calling you pretending to be white?

Speaker 23

I can always tell when I'm talking. To a \*\*\*\*\* also. Take you, for example, Ron.

Speaker 6

Over.

Speaker 9

Me. Yeah.

Speaker 5

Hey, Brian.

Speaker 23

I mean I. Can. Tell that you're a. Pure Aryan white man from the way you pronounce certain words.

Don't know, it's just. Becoming so real, I always thought it would. Be like a dream.

Speaker 28

Speaker 9

Speaker 22

Speaker 27

Speaker 22

About two names on your list. Work at NORAD.

Speaker 9

Good mystery men Steve and Jerry.

Speaker 22

'S real names are Harry Dricks and Kevin Nelson. Two clowns with top security clearances. These klansmen. We're in charge of monitoring our safety. Done a service to your country. We've been following an investigation. Impressive. Last night, Fort Carson reported several C4 explosives missing from their armoury. No suspects.

Speaker 12

Speaker 14

Cancelled. Why could be able to death threats.

Speaker 9

They're used to that.

Speaker 25

But nothing more about the explosives.

Speaker 10

Bucket. We get them on weapons charges and stop them from doing. Anything that way.

Speaker 9

America's going to hell in a handbasket.

Speaker 33

That started out as a nice spring day back there, Waco, TX.

Speaker

So.

Speaker 33

May 15th, 1916. Jesse Washington. Was a friend of mine. He was 17. I was 18. He kind of looked at Jesse and called him slow. Today. You'd call them. Mentally \*\*\*\*\*, they

claimed Jesse. Raped and murdered a white woman by the name. Of. Lucy fryer. He put Jessie on trial.

Speaker 14

Hey.

Speaker 33

I was convicted by an all white jury after they deliberated. For only four minutes.

Speaker 23

My brothers in Christ. Nobel Prize recipient Co, creator of the transistor and of dear, dear friend of mine Doctor William Shockley, whose groundbreaking scientific work ushered in the computer age, has proof. Through his research with eugenics. But each of us here has flowing through our veins, the genes of a superior race. It's a fact. It's a fact. It can't be disputed. Today. We celebrate that truth.

Speaker 10

Mask off hoods on.

Speaker 33

I was working across the street at the Shoeshine Baller. And after the verdict. The mob? Grand Jesse. For the chain around his neck and dragged him out of the courthouse.

Speaker 5

So.

Speaker 33

How do I have to hide?

Speaker 8

We.

Speaker 28

Be careful bro.

Speaker 20

Well, all right.

Speaker 33

Where I was the. Shoe Paula had a. Window open the attic and I could see the crowd. He marched as he through the streets. They stabbed him. And beat him. And finally, in a bloody heap. They held him down in the street. And cut off his testicles.

Speaker 23

God. Give us true. White men. The Invisible empire demands. Strong minds. Great hearts, true faith. Clean and. Ready hands. Men who have honour. Men who will not lie, men who can stand before a demagogue. And damn his treacherous flatteries without blinking. God give us real men. Courageous men who flinch not at duty. Ron Stallworth, are you willing to dedicate your? Life. To the protection. The preservation. And the advancement of the white race in mind. And body. In spirit. Be seated.

Speaker 33

The man had a photographer by the name of. Go to sleep. Came into pictures of the whole thing. Those pictures were later sold as postcards.

Speaker 20

Oh.

Speaker 23

Remove your hood.

Speaker 33

They put Jesse's charred body into a bag.

Speaker 25

Go ahead.

Speaker 33

Dragged him through town.

Speaker 23

Remove your hood.

Speaker 33

They sold the remains.

Speaker 23

Remove your hood.

Speaker 33

And submit it.

Speaker

Hello.

Speaker 33

Lot of good white folks is stood there like it was a 4th of July parade. They even let the children out of school or on lunch hour.

Speaker 23

Remove your head.

Speaker 33

And all I could do was to watch. And the hope. They wouldn't find me.

Speaker 4

Come welcome to Redmond, baptised by the light.

Speaker 33

One of the reasons they've done that that Jesse. Was. A movie. Called birth of a nation and it come out the year before and it was so powerful. They gave the Ku Klux Klan. Rebirth.

Speaker 34

We.

Speaker 16

Oh, look at that one. Ohh, he's disgusting. All those poor women. No, you feel it? Oh.

Today they had called that kind of movie a blockbuster. Everybody saw it. You're the president of the United States.
