Hey, Rick, you follow what's happening in Thailand? Some kids stuck in a cave.

Speaker 15

Yeah. No, not really. Why? How they get themselves in there?

Speaker 16

I don't know. Doesn't say.

Speaker 15

They walked in, they walked out.

Speaker 16

The Thai Government's been given a list of rescue divers. We're on the list.

Speaker 15

What cave is this?

Speaker 16

Turned away. Hey, Matthew, that would be your mum, Matthew Burn mapped it a couple of years ago.

Speaker 13

OK, OK.

Speaker 15

Yeah, yeah. Got it. I've no.

Speaker 16

That's the one, yeah.

Speaker 15

It's just a tourist cave.

Speaker 16

It looks easy, but Verne said when it's flooded. Impossible. We. Impossible for verb. They've got teams climbing all over the mountain and drilling holes and such holes one second.

Thailand got everything? Yeah.

Speaker

Speaker 2

Six days since the point last week.

Speaker 7

We're about twice.

Guys, I'm sorry, but we will have to walk from here.

Speaker 15

Gonna guess the creams there.

Speaker 5

Just wanna taste it.

Speaker 2

Yeah.

Speaker 11

Then.

Speaker 2

Stop.

Speaker 16

Thanks.

Speaker 11

Do you take two custard creams? No. Is it?

Speaker 5

You're like a.

Speaker 15

Child. I'm like a child.

Speaker 12

OK guys, it's the building on the left next to the laundry. I'll get the tanks and meet you there, OK.

We do all we can to do. Go in that cave.

Now we're meant to go in.

We just flew all the way from.

Speaker 11

England can I help?

Speaker 2

Wait.

Speaker 15

Hello, I'm Rick Stanton. This is John Valenton. You've been flown in by the Thai Government to help.

Speaker 3

You are British Army.

Speaker 11

British Cave Rescue Council we're volunteers. The Cave is flooded. Yeah, with John. Seems to be a problem here.

Speaker 5

Yeah, well, it's getting bad in there. If only. Everyone out. These are the men you want. I gave the governor their names.

Speaker 12

The governor sent Madam.

Speaker

No.

Speaker 11

Must be on some list somewhere.

Speaker 5

I told the governor these are the men you needed. The child. You're a silly of The Cave. Yeah. Look, John. Yeah, just a second because it look like it's just that they don't want foreigners dying in the caves. It's not a good look.

Speaker 11

Go.

Speaker 15

We won't die. I have 0 interest in dying. How about you John?

Speaker 16

Yes, hi.

Speaker 11

If the governor sent for. You can die.

Speaker 5

Thank you, lads. First it's going to be a series of small cascades followed by a deeper wading section before your first start. Your best chance is a large cave about. In.

From there.

Speaker

Nana.

Speaker 9

For. Me. How come I died? No, not alone.

Speaker

And.

Speaker 9

They must ask please do not go in The Cave again without my permission.

Speaker 5

Just check boys. Sir.

Speaker 11

What was all that? About.

Speaker 5

Well, in theory, the governor's in charge. But Captain announced the Navy chief on the ground. It doesn't take orders from civilians. Plus, the rumour is the governor's been Sacked. This was supposed to have been his last week here and now, as in order to stay on just in case. They need a full.

Speaker 15

Guy. Hey, Vern. What's all that? That's.

Speaker 5

Trying the Princess Nanon the sleeping Princess.

Speaker 12

This is hot mountain Mango mountain.

Speaker 5

They say when you see it from a distance, it looks like a sleeping Princess.

They say that her tears trapped the boy. The Sleeping Princess is angry.

Speaker 15

Angry. What's she angry about?

I don't know. It's just what the local people say.

Speaker 18

Excuse me, governor. Major Charlie Hodges, US Air Force, Okinawa. This is Captain Olivia Stapp. We're the nearest special operations spot, but we have medics, Coms, logistics experts. We'll do whatever we can to help.

Yes.

Speaker 4

OK.

Speaker 6

Thank you.

Speaker 7

Thank you. Thank you everybody.

Speaker 10

OK.

Speaker 9

We're going to get started. Now. So we think that the boys were heading for here, they call it Patiya Beach.

Speaker 3

We're here.

Speaker 9

With the high water level and the low visibility and the difficulty of the camp itself. Our divers were not able to reach them. So now the question is. When do we go back in? And who is going?

Speaker

In.

Speaker 12

We need the rain to stop and let the pumps do the work. And then we go in.

Speaker 15

We can go in.

Speaker 5

Now, yeah, no offence, but you're trained to dive in open water, not confined spaces. Rick and I have been diving in caves just like this for 30 years now. Takes a certain kind of mindset for the deep cave diving breathing techniques, special ways of moving. And it's just different.

Speaker 12

I'm responsible for my men.

Speaker 19

As for anyone else.

Speaker 9

That's for the governor to decide.

Speaker 1

OK.

Speaker 9

No, I'm not going for now. We wait for the way. To stop. Thank you.

Speaker 2

And.

Speaker

And.

Speaker 16

I'm the water guy.

Speaker 9

You are American.

Speaker

Yeah, let's wake up.

Speaker 9

I am the governor.

Speaker

You need time.

Speaker 14

Yep.

Speaker 9

No problem, you guys let it.

Speaker 7

Damn amazing you don't like.

Speaker 9

So at the top. Nothing happened.

Speaker 11

Now.

Speaker

10. Hmm. What can get the?

Speaker 15

Nice.

Speaker

All right. Well on. I think.

Speaker 8

With this much needed break in the monsoon rains consensus among the many volunteers.

Speaker 11

Here is that the search.

Speaker 8

For the boys and their coach may soon resume the frustration for the families, though, he didn't really seem to know when that might be, or indeed how often take place nine days after they ended this huge pay system. The question remains as to whether the boys can still be ready.

There has been no contact with the boy.

Speaker 16

What's it like for them?

Speaker

Still.

Speaker 15

Why say that?

Speaker 1

Oh.

He was just wondering.

Huh. Another. I can just about see you. Princess Nang Nong.

Speaker 14

We just received word that a water diversion operation is underway. Volunteers are building dams and positioning pipes in order to redirect the water from the mountains into the surrounding fields. Rescue teams hope that this will limit the flow of water into The Cave and allow the pumps to reduce the water.

Right. I'll keep left. Feel our four bodies. No.

Speaker 17

Yeah.

Speaker 15

Have they done?

Speaker 11

English English.

Speaker 6

Speaker 11

No, not today. Now there are just two of us. We must die, but many people are coming. It's OK. We are the first. But. But but many will come many more. Better 10 days, 10 days. You're very strong emotion.

I know, I know, I know. I understand. OK, go back. We will come.

Speaker 11

Speaker 6

What day you come and help us?

Speaker 11

Oh. We have tomorrow. Tomorrow. Yeah. More diamonds. Thai diamonds. We'll come tomorrow with food and doctors and everything.

Don't tell me you don't know that.

Speaker 14

Thank you.

Speaker 4

Thank you.

Speaker 11

She was very pleased.

Speaker 6

Team and we help each other help us. Because of our coach, we are stay strong. He teach us to meditate. And pray, pray and yes, yes.

Speaker 11

Found the boys. They're alive.

Speaker 15

Carefully sees that.

Speaker

Oh yeah. Hi.

Speaker 12

Night. Night.

Speaker 11

How many of you?

Speaker 14

What the hell?

Speaker 9

Hollywood career.

Speaker 12

Hang up.

Speaker 7

We have.

Speaker

Right.

Speaker 2

Yeah.

Speaker 15

Ohh ****, everybody knows that didn't take long.

Speaker 2

What's your next?

Speaker

Give me.

Speaker 10

Come on.

Speaker 14

Channel.

Speaker 17

We're going to bring you some breaking news now. Reports coming in from Chiang Rai, Thailand's specialist cave rescue divers, Rick Stanton, a retired firefighter, and John Blanton, an IT consultant, have found the missing boys and their football. Coach last seen nine days ago and presumed trapped in the flooded caves. All 12 boys and their coach are now confirmed to be alive.

Speaker 16

There's more of them. Now when we should just go. Let's go straight to the van.

Speaker 2

Please.

Speaker 11

Inside.

Speaker 14

Thank you very much.

Speaker

Invite.

Speaker 12

Thank you. OK.

Speaker 9

Thank you so much you found them.

Speaker 6

The nose guys can be.

Speaker

A pain in the ****. You just gotta handle them, right?

Speaker 15

What do you want me to tell them? We found the boys. Now that's all watching die.

Speaker 16

OK, Rick, take it in.

Speaker 15

I'm just telling it like it is. All this water pumping, flooding fields, praying to shrine this *****. I'm not having it.

Speaker

The Thai seals are going in.

Speaker 15

Tomorrow, boys are never coming out. Never.

Speaker 9

Our most experienced drivers are going to go.

Speaker 15

No, Sir, it's not about your divers. We brought a man out on our first dive, but he completely panicked, almost drowned. And that was a very short swim. You try and dive those kids the whole way. Or you could bring out is dead bodies.

Speaker 11

Governor, Governor, governor, governor.

Speaker 14

OK, let's get you guys.

Speaker

Out of here.

Speaker 5

This is exactly why I didn't.

Speaker 1

Want.

Speaker 16

Well, we knew we'd find. Them.

Speaker 15

I didn't expect to find them.

Speaker 16

Alive. Well, it's done that.

Speaker 7

Can't you get them all out? Here.

Speaker 2

Now.

Speaker 11

I think can we go guys please.

Speaker

The word come.

Speaker 6

How long? Hyundai human. Or. Hi, Jay, how?

Speaker 1

Hi.

Speaker

Double check. Michael.

Speaker 15

On your first dive. You made it to the tea junction.

Speaker

I did, yeah.

Speaker 15

Do you want a briefing on on the rest of the way?

Speaker 19

Yeah, please come in.

Speaker 15

You made it here. You have a 250 metre dive here with a narrow rift barely shoulder wide to chamber 7. Then you have to deck.

Speaker

It.

Speaker 15

And carry your gear over a long rock shelf. Get to Pattaya beach. Then comes the tough.

Speaker 5

Dive.

Speaker 15

It's a long, shallow tunnel, bit more twisty than this, 350 metres, low visibility pulling against very strong currents.

Speaker 16

No head room at all, and there's undercuts and all the bends that are very, very dangerous.

Speaker 15

So you must. Always keep to the wider side of the. Line where you'll get trapped. At the end of that. You're reachable.

Speaker 16

And it's a very physical dive, so try and save 2/3 of your ear going in so you.

Speaker 5

Can make it back. We'll get there. We reach the.

Speaker 18

Boys today.

Speaker 16

Best of luck here.

Speaker

Thank you.

Speaker 11

Thank you.

Speaker 9

Good luck.

Speaker 19

They'll do a good.

Speaker 10

Job.

Speaker 19

Those are our boys in there.

Speaker 15

Look, I know you're mental. It's not going to be easy for them.

Speaker 1

And.

Speaker 2

That.

Speaker 11

Well, on the way to the owner.

Speaker

But.

Speaker 6

There's a lot of.

Speaker 2

They're back away.

Speaker 6

Hello.

Speaker 2

I need it.

Speaker 1

Perhaps.

Speaker

2 1/2.

Speaker 6

Lima. I'm OK.

Speaker 1

Yeah.

Speaker 15

Promise.

Speaker 7

OK.

Speaker 18

Possible.

Speaker

Time. You think I kiss you there? The typing way.

Speaker 13

OK.

Speaker

You. Don't know. All right.

Speaker 11

With the queue.

Speaker 3

Great.

Speaker 9

Here. OK. Created my hip mutiny. Doctor.

Speaker 19

So.

Speaker 9

The dictum of a day young blood pick up.

Speaker

Until like now. Dinner in my car.

Speaker 10

Everything OK?

Speaker

Well, she's afraid her boy won't be rescued. There are Chan from Myanmar, just over the border. In my life. Say again? 1 coming out.

Speaker 14

That's.

Speaker 9

So.

Speaker 10

Leave your team.

Speaker 16

Somebody's gonna have to come up with something. Rick. Ohh, what are you thinking?

Speaker 15

Just a crazy idea.

Speaker 16

So tell me. But crazy is better than nothing. We've got nothing.

Speaker 15

We call Harry.

Speaker 16

Hurry, Doctor Harris. That's brilliant.

Speaker 15

For insane ohh.

Speaker

OK.

Speaker 16

Both.

Speaker 15

I don't know if.

Speaker 16

He'd do it. I don't know. I don't know the man, but. I mean. That you come. If you thought was just to lend a hand.

Speaker 1

The man.

Speaker 15

You may buy that. He's a good diver, yeah.

Speaker 16

We could use a couple more divers who can handle rescue work. Anyway, I was thinking Jason. You know, if he's not too ***** *** that he hasn't been asked already. Maybe Chris Jewell. You think Chris would be up to it?

Speaker 11

Everyone says he's excellent.

Speaker 15

Jason says he's strong because he's never been arrested. Like this? I'll call them, yeah.

Speaker 16

OK.

Speaker 9

Chris, let me show you. So you are carrying one meal. Every day for one week, for everyone in.

Speaker 11

The care.

Speaker 7

All right. OK. Yeah.

Speaker 15

Keep telling Christian. Yeah, he'll be right. He's young. We'll never young. Rick, not that far beyond.

Speaker 2

We have.

Speaker

Why?

Speaker 6

No.

Speaker

Speaker 1

So kids might like to write back to their parents, yeah.

Speaker

The parents knots from the boys.

Speaker 7

So they passed. They passed.

Speaker 11

No, you were terrible. You did great.

Speaker 5

Well, that's quite a Dave. How the hell do you think going to get those kids out?

Speaker 15

We're working on it.

Speaker 3

Just kick it left on the picture with that last time Belgium beat Brazil. The favourites have been knocked out, the World Cup. Belgium are through to the semi.

The recent death of Thai Navy SEAL Saman Gunan is reminding everyone of just how incredibly dangerous and challenging it is in the caves. This was a trained Navy diver. How much more difficult will it be for the 12 children and their coach?

Speaker

Yeah. Good.

Speaker 17

Rescuers are now attempting to source diving equipment and wet suits for the smallest of the boys, with no alternate entrances and oxygen running low, diving them out still appears to be the best option. The entire nation is anxiously waiting for what will happen next.

There will be no more Navy divers going beyond the Cambridge tree until further notice.

I just can't answer that. Because I've never done it before. As far as I know, nobody ever has. In theory. It could work. If they wake up underwater. That they can drown.
