Moments ago, something plane crashed into the tower of the World Trade Centre. See the smoke coming out of the of the tower. We have no idea of what it was. It was a tremendous.

Unbelievable.

Speaker 1

Just a few moments ago, you can hear around me emergency vehicles heading towards the scene. Now this could have been a an aircraft or it could have been something internal. It appears to be something coming from the outside, but due to the nature of the opening on about the. 100th floor of the South tower of the World Trade Centre.

You say anything about that?

Speaker 10

Then.

Speaker 1

What the world said the tower #1 is on fire. Confirm this is for farm.

Oh my God, dude. What is up with the dude that is ***** **?

Speaker 11

Box.

Speaker 13

That's the building, yeah.

Speaker 10

Holy man.

Speaker 1

Right.

Speaker 8

Jesus Christ.

Speaker 14

Four days ago to.

Speaker 1

Do we have any report on a fire condition yet from on scene personnel? Several schools on fire. Is this the second alarm right now?

Speaker 11

This is the third alarm transmitter.

Speaker 15

David 10/4.

Speaker 17

Oh man, are you there?

Speaker 16

So I just saw the hugest explosion.

Speaker 13

Oh yeah, definitely.

Speaker 16

Yeah, yeah, we're plenty for our.

Speaker 8

I.

Speaker 18

Apparently a plane went right through.

Speaker 8

Just one of hundreds of people dead.

Speaker 18

Oh my God.

Speaker 19

Good evening. Good morning. Actually we have. Breaking news this out of. In. Manhattan a plane is allegedly crashed into the World Trade Centre. Details at this hour very sketchy just a few moments ago. Allegedly, a plane has crashed into the World Trade Centre. We don't have any reports of what type of plane. What? Perhaps the carrier was. How many injuries are there right now? Police and fire units are being dispatched to the scene as we speak. Again, these are all these sketchy details. We'll just stay with pictures you're looking at live pictures right now from News Chopper 7.

You could see it from the Lincoln Tunnel and everything where we would get pulling into the Lincoln Tunnel and everybody stood up on the bus, huh? I can't. I don't know. I can't see. Chris told me they locked all the doors and everything's flying all over the place. There's people everywhere.

Hey.

Speaker 21

I don't know.

Speaker 20

Right in the middle of the building, you know, everything just went right. No, that's the World Trade Centre. What? The world. The twin towers, the buildings that they that. That long? Yeah. That that. Yeah, all the way downtown. When they went, almost got blown up that time.

Speaker 22

The same thing.

Speaker 1

There's video all the way down, down.

Speaker 12

Oh my God.

Speaker 20

Sorry for whatever month the people was up on that floor, you know.

Speaker 8

Yeah, I.

Speaker 23

And we're trying to gather some information as to what type of plane this might have been into this into this area. I can tell you as as we are looking here at the north side of The North Face of Tower #1, the gas that is in the building runs from about 10 storeys up to about 15 stories going from right to left. And now we have quite a bit of smoke and

flame pouring out of the eastern side of Tower #1 and at this point, Jeff, that is, that is all we have. We are still looking at smoke billowing out of tower #1.

Oh, I was walking down. Chambers Street and fully saw the entire event. With my own eyes, I saw the entire. I saw the plane from the Sky pass right into it. Amazing.

I'm telling you, the whole tower is on fire. Yeah, because there's black smoke coming out of the one side. I hope it wasn't a terrorist attack. Because that means tunnels and necks, bridges and next you know this is this is not good. Not good at all.

Straight into the building.

Speaker 27

Can you imagine?

Speaker 13

The people who work in there catching 5, they must be going crazy right now.

OK.

Speaker 29

Hello Mam 5, apartment 328.

Speaker 30

This is Verizon operator 2764. We have 100 people trapped on the 105th floor of the one World Trade Centre. OK. Want to know if they should evacuate?

Speaker 29

Really, they should remain where they are and they could put something to block the smoke from coming in under the door because we were in the building and the hall with the with the smoke, we should not go in the hallway. OK. All right.

Speaker 30

They've already started the time breaking the windows or panicking on that floor.

Speaker 29

I understand, ma'am. We'll be doing the best that we have. OK, alright, thank you.

Speaker 10

OK.

Speaker 12

Cell phones don't even work. Sorry, go over one more block down this way.

Speaker 31

Everybody's running away.

Speaker 10

Somebody's power. Sonny's power.

Speaker 32

Well.

Speaker 8

Wake up.

Speaker 10

It's not right back further build this but.

Speaker 20

That's.

Speaker 34

You can't stay here. I'm sorry. You gotta go. Go.

Speaker 33

Let's go. Let's go.

Speaker 2

That what is that falling?

Speaker 5

Oh my God. Don't be a person. Oh my God.

Speaker 3

Here. Where? That right there.

Speaker 35

What are those big, heavy things falling at a rate that a piece of paper would not fall?

Oh my God.

Speaker 3

Yeah, I remember, you know, 102 minutes when you guys originally asked for our footage. I thought, why do they want? Like, why do they want this? Why do they want to interview us? And then now, 15 years later, having watched it, I realised, oh, This is why they wanted it. We were children, you know, we had this very unique perspective where we're old enough to understand what's going on almost instantly, kind of young enough to not know what's going on with my point of view. And mature enough to be able to sort of narrate it without realising we're narrating it.

And our friend Phil is either with us or in the elevator.

Yeah. Live e-mail me or Facebook message me and said hey, I was in that elevator on that TV show.

Speaker 4

We both get messages on Facebook and Twitter on 9/11 from people who've seen the footage, and it somehow our experience in particular resonates with them.

But The thing is, it's a universal reaction, which is empathy. People see it and they just feel so they like. They just wanna. They always say just want to hug you.

Those first five years were hard. You know, we saw we saw things nobody should have to see. I remember seeing people standing in those windows. And we were. We were close enough that we could see them holding hands. Ready to jump? I couldn't talk about it with anyone, and I also felt like my perspective was rather insignificant knowing that those people were. Lined up in windows and their only option was to jump to their death. What did it matter that I saw that and that I was feeling terrible? About. What I was feeling inside it, it just didn't seem justified when so many people died and so many people lost their husbands and wives and sons and daughters that. You know that I was allowed to feel what I was feeling. I think the worst minute, like personally, of that day for me was hearing Caroline say, like, don't leave me. I wasn't leaving you.

Sure look like.

I was making you move faster still best still best friends, right. I get that question a lot from people who have seen the documentary.

Speaker 28

That's.

Speaker 47

Yeah. Even though she tried to ditch me that day.

Speaker 4

She's the only person in this world who knows exactly what I experienced that day and. Can probably like anticipate any anxiety that we could possibly have before, you know anyone else in our lives around. It's nice knowing there's at least one other person out there that knows what I went through that day.

Another all right, Carl's number one.

Apparently that was another plane we have witnessed. That was a second plane that just blew.

It's been another one, Carl.

Speaker 1

Yes, he hitting building #1.

Speaker 48

The other building.

Speaker 1

Yeah, he flew right into it. South side SE.

Speaker 48

Corner. OK. We're seeing like it, it looks like some kind of sick confetti parade. There is debris flying out of that S tower.

Speaker 11

Underground, underground.

Speaker 10

Please.

Speaker 33

Brian. Ryan from the bar, Ryan.

Speaker 10

No.

Speaker 11

Oh.

Speaker 33

No.

Speaker 1

The other.

Speaker 29

Yeah.

Speaker 1

Tower 2/3 of the way up you got missile fire shown out there suggest to the new city commander for David to transmit A50 line to Tower 2.

Speaker 10

2nd.

Speaker 1

That flight was a large farmer style complete aircraft into the second tower. Goodbye.

Speaker 49

Creative.

Speaker 10

Holy ****.

Speaker 50

***** hell.

Speaker 25

That's terrorists.

Speaker 19

I can't believe I just saw that.

Speaker 18

Both trade towers.

Speaker 17

Good God.

Speaker 12

In the other building.

Speaker 8

Huh.

Speaker 33

Ohh.

Speaker 12

See.

Speaker 26

Ohh you see it on television? Yeah, this will be. It's gonna be a lot of deaths.

Speaker 22

Then.

Speaker 32

No pool football.

Speaker 26

So both of them are on fire now.

Speaker 8

Man, I don't know, man.

Speaker 52

What just hit it? Aeroplane that the way was the first. No, the first. No. What? What was that? That was it. I I could tell that was the United that it looked like it. I swear. It looked like a united aeroplane that crashed into the side.

Speaker 51

Another one.

Speaker 52

Of the the one that just came in now.

Speaker 18

Gotcha. Talking, understand.

Speaker 54

Christ reporting staff in the field is telling us you can see now to the left of your screen. There's fire in the second tower.

Speaker 28

My the other tower.

Speaker 53

Just blew up. Oh my God.

Speaker 8

Just a little right at the bottom of the.

Speaker 35

Oh my God, I'm shaking World Trade Centre on.

Speaker 54

1st that we've heard the impact only affecting tower one.

Speaker 30

The left side.

Speaker 55

No, it's not coming down.

Speaker 33

You have to look at the window out the window.

Speaker 37

Bring Hillary smokes are coming the phone or explosion. We do not know what the bomb speaking.

Speaker 24

Return here a second explosion that just happened the first we understand was from an aeroplane. The second we had no idea.

Speaker 54

OK, no idea at all at this. Point what has triggered it. If we could take maybe a. A wider shot.

Speaker 11

Unbelievable, ladies and gentlemen.

Speaker 55

Look, it's on fire.

Speaker 53

Another explosion. We're just told we.

Speaker 55

How do you get to that you don't?

Speaker 8

Get to that.

Speaker 33

Know they're gonna help these people.

Speaker 55

First, they had to get the people out, then they fight the fire. How do they?

Speaker 35

Do that. I can't believe what I'm looking at right now. I just can't believe.

Speaker 29

5328 What's the address? If you feel that's necessary, so I cannot. Yeah, I'm not there. I cannot advise you. If you feel that is message OK, have you covered the doorway? Have yourself the doorway with. Did you put something in the doorway to block the? I'm 328, but we have personnel there. We're on the way.

Break.

Speaker 29

If you feel you must, I cannot direct you what happened straight away. Please do, man. Thank you.

Oh man.

Speaker 11

Why this batch?

Speaker 1

Of 414 what is the address?

Speaker 49

88th floor. What building?

Speaker 56

Building tool. You've seen any firemen? As of yet, they're.

Speaker 1

There, but this corner. So it's two world trend 88 floor of the northwest corner.

Speaker 30

Right, my Auntie Alley is coming up the floor at 89.

Speaker 56

89 or 88.

Speaker 49

88 I hope.

Speaker 56

All right, we're in the building. I'm going to convey the information to the emergency guys.

Speaker 49

All the way up now.

Speaker 1

That's.

Speaker 16

One second. Yeah, we copy. Once again, we're live over the West side of Manhattan. We're up around 79th St, about 5 miles north of the World Trade Centre, and again to recap the events here this morning as we are assembling them is at at approximately 8:45 this morning an aeroplane travelling from north to South struck the north tower.

Chair of the World Trade Centre shortly after that, as the first building was engulfed in plain. In flames, we were on our way to the scene and we witnessed a second aeroplane strike, the South side of the second tower, the South tower, and that is the 2nd row of flames that you see here as far as air traffic in the New York metropolitan area, all operations at the New York airports, being Newark, John F Kennedy International and LaGuardia Airport. All air traffic operations has been suspended as far as other aircraft traffic right now, us included. We are being kept at a distance of five miles from the site of this absolute disaster.

Speaker 10

Funny thing with USA.

Speaker 57

He's just great. You know, guys, if that's happening.

Speaker 58

We gotta get. The hell out of here. Sorry about that.

Speaker 50

Yeah, what happened?

Speaker 38

Half my company. Is in both those towers and floors that got hit. I can't get through. I was there only six months ago. My, my, my office is now midtown.

Speaker 21

What company?

Speaker 38

Marsh, McLennan, Marsh, Inc, Mercer Consulting Group William and Mercer Putnam and Guy Carpenter occupy all floors in that range. There that. Got looks like that got hit.

Speaker 8

So.

Speaker 2

I'm devastated. I can't imagine this happening to waves. I just have some very dear old friends. OK.

Speaker 10

OK.

Speaker 38

What else you want to take in AAA?

Speaker 49

You need you need that.

Speaker 13

Really.

Speaker 12

Let's go. Let's go. Go way back. Come on, come on. We're just moving back here. We're going to say perimeter. Let's go. Going you're.

Speaker 10

Everybody, please get that.

Speaker 1

Come. We need them on West St. Come on, West.

Speaker 10

It's gonna get the **** out of here.

Speaker 13

Alright.

Speaker 12

It's got invested literally looking at. Get the **** out of here.

Speaker 22

No.

Speaker 39

Oh.

Speaker 10

Oh my gosh, that's spotter. Down the police want everybody off the road. Hurry up.

Speaker 25

It's a terrorist. Do you think what they're playing?

Speaker 59

There.

Speaker 19

Yeah, the two planes one way up. There were two another one just hit it.

Speaker 60

Yeah.

Speaker 25

I did not know that.

Speaker 31

It's another aircraft hitting.

Speaker 19

There's gotta be.

Speaker 10

I'm coming down. I'm coming down.

Speaker 25

This is serious, but serious stuff.

Speaker 10

Right, let's go.

Speaker 12

No.

Speaker 25

They're evacuating the whole building.

Speaker 61

You're bad. It's better because it's our business. Really high. We don't know. It's gonna happen. I'm the second plane hit.

Speaker 25

Yeah, a second plane hit. That's that's that's on purpose then.

Speaker 62

Yeah.

Speaker 46

British Airways.

Speaker 25

Was it was the British Airways.

Speaker 2

With a commercial airline.

Speaker 25

Yeah, I saw that one, but a second one hit too.

Speaker 19

Someone said it was the British Airways hit the Second World trade, right?

Speaker

In the middle.

Speaker 50

You're kidding.

Speaker 25

This is ***** unbelievable. ***** unbelievable.

Speaker 17

Jumping right there.

Speaker 15

Oh my goodness. God. Oh my God.

Speaker 48

I don't think there's any way they can.

Speaker 58

Get up there.

Speaker 52

What can you do exactly?

Speaker 23

I wonder if they both hit from the front.

Speaker 18

Did did you? Do you know that did?

Speaker 22

They both hit from the harp.

Speaker 51

Now that they said that on the news, they said the second plane came around circle and came back.

Speaker 25

Yeah, that that second point.

Speaker 63

Right and hit from the other side.

Speaker 18

Yes, no one expected it early in the morning.

Speaker 33

I was watching it. I saw it.

Speaker 31

I can only begin to imagine.

Speaker 12

You know, people are dead.

Speaker 18

You don't have any idea how many people was.

Speaker 61

The second one.

Speaker 11

You think they were built there, might have still been people in the building?

Speaker 31

And on the second, hit him.

Speaker 64

That was a different power.

Speaker 31

I do know that there were major efforts to. Have disaster drills to have. Preparedness plan in the event of an awful tragedy like this, but one has to wonder how, with the two gigantic Skype and the Fire Department, Emergency services can handle both in that confined space.

Speaker 22

I can't. I can't. This is another. Two planes 2.

Speaker 12

Planes.

Speaker 22

I seen the first one. I saw the explosion the first one, but I thought it was a bomb, but then they said no. It was a plane. All of a. Suddenly it gets from the same thing, and now I hear somebody said in the news that they said they going to do it. For 1/2 hour, so they should plug.

Speaker 5

You're going to fill a plane into this thing every half hour.

Speaker 64

And it done enough I mean.

Speaker 5

We were standing right below the second one and then just went back to get.

Speaker 64

After the first one, we went all the way down there. We were on Church Street and I said I want to get a different camera and we walked back the next one. We were right.

Speaker 57

Yeah.

Speaker 54

2nd.

Speaker 16

You're not in a good place to be in that one.

Speaker 35

Blair.

Speaker 22

I I have looked for you. I think everybody is like leaving from the. Everybody is leaving the area. I mean, this is ridiculous. Who knows what what can happen?

Speaker 5

Oh yeah.

Speaker 1

Flow.

Speaker 18

We have.

Speaker 1

Yep. Yes, I appear to be getting water on the on this fire. If you can see the the flames on the South power which appear to be getting lesser and lesser is where the smoke is progressing, getting progressively lighter and lighter indicating. Better than by our officials are getting closer to to putting this fire out.

Speaker 13

It's not safe here. It's not safe here. Do me a favour, OK?

Speaker 32

Somebody.

Speaker 11

I had a field. Hi field comp, number one, World Trade Centre, the 103 floor southwest corner and northwest corner reported to be 100 people overcome at that location, repeating train centre, 103rd Floor, N Corner 100 people in that location. Also, lattice freeze reporting from the 3530 fifth floor going up. Understand well, they got numerous things feeding numerous injuries from Burns occupied in the cells at this time.

Speaker 37

No conversation.

Speaker 8

What?

Speaker 33

What happened?

Speaker 10

This way.

Speaker 59

First of all, we were just in the building and we just looking out, even if we saw the paper going around and we're looking out all of a sudden we seen the plane come from this direction. Yeah, I told you we're right through this building right over here.

Speaker 33

You want to say, yeah.

Speaker 11

Who blocks away?

Speaker 32

Second plane came from that side to the side.

Speaker 20

Two blocks away, our debut 2 blocks away come.

Speaker 59

On let's go.

Speaker 50

Yeah.

Speaker 10

Did you feel the first one or you the first one?

Speaker 32

No, no, we just looked out the window. We were in the building and we saw we said, what did the Yankees win the World Series again, there's like a ticker tape parade. We were joking around. And then we looked out the window and realised that the builder was our fire. We didn't hear what's the last and we came down to check it out.

Speaker 57

I saw it all. I was in the 50th floor of the Millennium Hilton and I was getting ready to.

Speaker 47

Were you in the building?

Speaker 57

Call my wife. I heard the wine of a jet. It had the nose down, it was hauling ***. I looked up and I thought, what is this plane doing coming so fast? And it just slammed right into the power.

Speaker 5

No, you're kidding. You're kidding me. What?

Speaker 13

Just freak out.

Speaker 8

Yeah.

Speaker 5

Holy Mother of God.

Speaker 31

And they were hijacked. Or the?

Speaker 5

Apparently. Well, that's what the neighbours were just saying, that apparently they were hijacking that the FBI got word that these two planes were hijacked and then suddenly they have one crashing into the building and then the next one crashing in about 20 minutes later.

Speaker 51

A Flint front of the Flint House.

Speaker 13

Hell yeah.

Speaker 33

That was crazy, man.

Speaker 7

Hijack a ***** plane.

Speaker 58

But if it got hijacked then.

Speaker 22

The first one. The second, yeah.

Speaker 59

That didn't look that big when it hit.

Speaker

Now.

Speaker 52

You can see the glass shattering right now, little by little.

Speaker 12

I look horrible, but it could have been.

Speaker 56

I couldn't tell. It was like a big regular.

Speaker 37

I'm not going to be able to get through.

And from what we see, we are seeing big chunks of the building. Cloud to the ground, but there is truly a scene of chaos here on the ground, and folks are looking in the air, afraid for another impact.

President Bush, speaking from an elementary school in Florida.

Speaker 37

May God bless. The victims, their families and America, thank you very much. Brief comments.

Apparently we didn't catch the beginning of it, but he was talking about this being a terrorist attack and talked about getting the folks responsible about the folks inside the World Trade Centre 45 minutes after the first plane crash into the building. We have yet to hear Word 1.

Speaker 56

A fire dispatcher, 41, only address at the fire.

Speaker 1

Alright, listen to me. Listen to me. You said you're on two World Trade.

Speaker 56

And you're on the 105th floor.

Speaker 1

Any particular corner over?

Speaker 56

And that. The the the Fire department is on scene. That's what I can give you at this time. I'll relating information to the units. Senator. So I understand, I'm sorry.

If they're going to keep them in the air at this point, the Capitol building, the Treasury and the White House have now all been evacuated. Plane crashed into the Pentagon just a little while after the two planes crashed into the two towers of the World Trade Centre here in New York.

It's and actually when I walked by and just took a peek in and looked and I said, Laurie, that was just that. And she was like, no way. I said, yeah, rewind it. And then I called or texted my whole family and called my mother and notified them. Of it and then. We all. Watched it. I don't. Yeah.

Do I can't get downstairs. I don't know what you should do.

Kelly Edwards reporting live from downtown where so many thousands and thousands of people are waiting to hear the fate of the loved ones after the World Trade Centre S tower completely collapsed, the north in flames. Here's what we do know about the apparent hijackings of these jetliners that crashed into the buildings. One of the planes was hijacked out of Boston, according to FAA sources, and now we're learning that another source, conditioned as speaking on a condition of anonymity, says that second plane. Was flown out of Newark.
